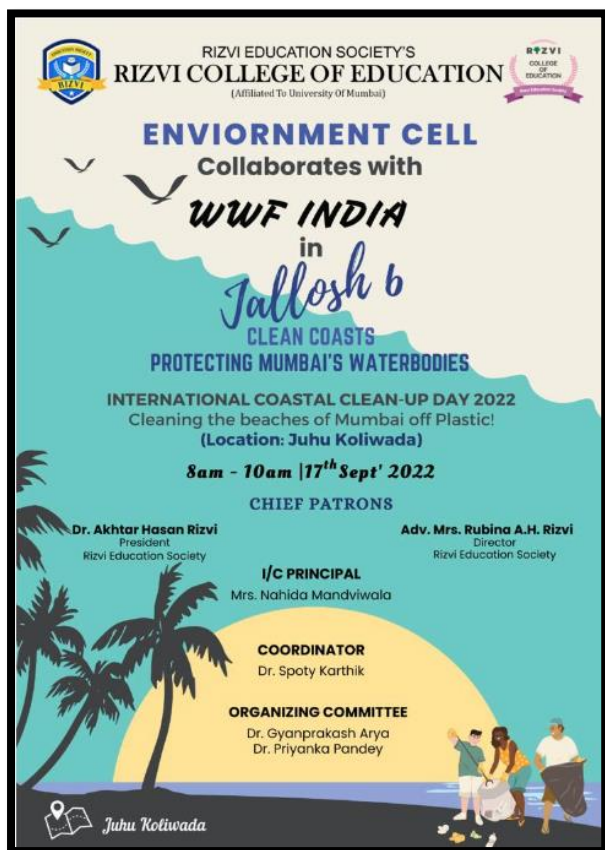

**Jalosh Beach CleanUp Drive** - On September 17, 2022, Rizvi College of Education organised a beach clean-up drive in partnership with World Wide Fund (WWF) India to mark International Coastal Cleanup Day, 2022. The goal of the International Coastal Clean-up Day was to restore cleanliness and purity to nature as a whole and to raise awareness of the growing marine pollution problem. Along with other corporate and citizens volunteers, Rizvi College of Education students and staff members picked up trash from a 1-kilometer length of Juhu Koliwada beach. At the event, volunteers gave students a clear understanding of garbage segregation. Waste was gathered and divided into biodegradable and non-biodegradable components.
