Swachta Hi Seva 2023 (October 1, 2023) - In 2014, our Hon. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi initiated Swachh Bharat, a nationwide cleanliness campaign, which resonated with citizens, making it a household name. As a prelude to Gandhi Jayanti, Hon. Prime Minister, appealed for 1 hour of shramdaan for swachhata at 10 am on 1st Oct by all citizens collectively as a 'swachhanjali' to Bapu on the eve of his Jayanti.
