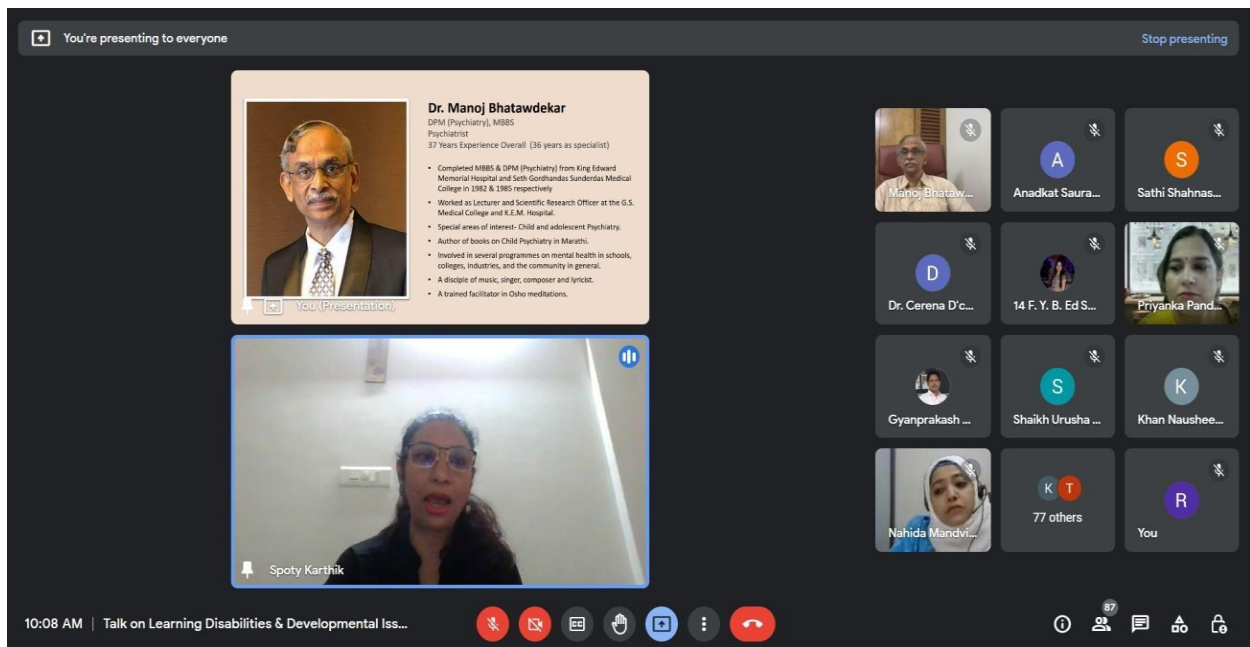
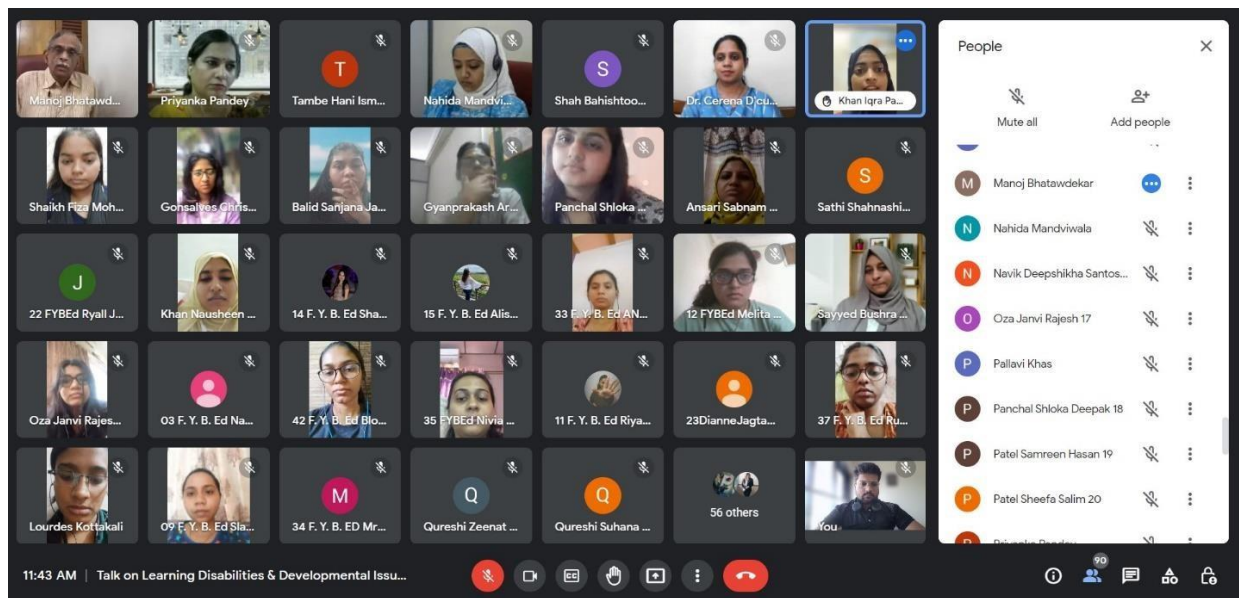


Figure 1 Dr. Spoty Karthik introducing Dr. Bhatawdekar
