This has reference to your letter dated 10th June, 2003 together with the letters referred above, requesting permission for affiliation to start a B.Ed. Degree Course at Bandra, Mumbai-400 050 from the academic year 2003-2004.

According to the said Government Resolution, 50% seats shall
be filled up from the respective minority students and remaining 50%
shall be filled up from the Open category students including 50%
SC/ST/DT-NT/OBC. If your college has been granted minority status
by the Government of Maharashtra then only you have to follow the
above criteria, otherwise you have to fill up 50% seats from open
category and 50% from reserved category.





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So far as 15% Management Quota is concerned the 15% seats shall be counted on total intake and remaining 85% shall be distributed as under :
