ABOUT THE THEME

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav-

'Janjatiya Vikas-Tribal Empowerment'



To mark India's 77th Independence Day, RES's Rizvi College of Education is organizing its 6th Edition of Inter College & Inter School Digital Poster Making Competition, themed '*Janjatiya Vikas – Tribal Empowerment.*' Tribal Empowerment is an essential aspect of *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav*, as it recognizes the contributions and rights of indigenous communities in India. The posters can be based on sub themes-

- **Tribal Education:** Eklavya Schools are changing the face of education amongst tribals.

- **Tribal Sports:** Indigenous sports and games of rural and tribal people.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES FOR DIGITAL POSTERS

- ✓ This competition platform is free and is open for School Students from standard 8th to 10th & College Students.
- ✓ Poster must be of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) or A2 size (420 x 594 mm).
- ✓ School students have the option of making poster manually and send it in pdf/jpeg format.
- ✓ Poster must include a message/slogan of not more than 8 words.
- ✓ Posters can be curated using online graphic design tools.
- ✓ Posters must be sent in high resolution .png/ .jpeg format.
- ✓ It is mandatory that all participants must submit their digital poster along with an image of their school/college identity card. All entries will be accepted only on the following link:

- ✓ The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

PARAMETERS TO JUDGE THE DIGITAL POSTERS

- ✓ Coverage of the topic
- ✓ Organization/logical sequencing of ideas
- ✓ Layout and design
- ✓ Relevance to the theme
- ✓ Clarity of the slogan/message
- ✓ Creativity & Originality
- ✓ Impact and presentation

All meritorious entries (two from college and two from school), that meet high standards as judged by the experts, will be awarded 'Certificate of Merit' & 'Winning Trophy'
