Rizvi College of Education (RCoEd) student teachers in collaboration with Help Yourself Foundation undertook a commendable initiative by organizing a food box distribution drive at

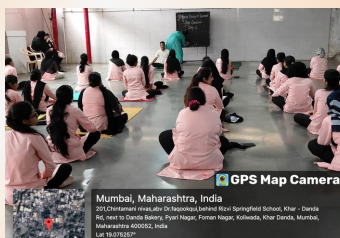

NAAC Visit RCoEd (October 18th and 19th)

On October 18 and 19, 2023, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Peer Team, visited Rizvi Education Society's Rizvi College of Education in Mumbai. The team was constituted by the Chairperson Professor Dr. Thirumalai Kumar Subramanian (Tamil Nadu Physical Education And Sports University), the Member Coordinator Prof. C Madhumathi, (Department Of Education, Osmania University), and member Dr. Anil Kumar (Principal, Mehar Chand College Of Education, Rupnagar, Punjab).

An extensive conversation with Dr. Spoty Karthik, the college principal, marked the start of the assessment process. The IQAC coordinator Mrs. Nahida Mandviwala along with the IQAC members, had an in-depth meeting with the Peer Team members. The meeting enabled the peer team members to gauge the quality initiative undertaken by the college at different stages for the growth and progress of the students and the institution. During their visit, the Peer Team inspected and appraised the college's curricula, research initiatives, value added courses, infrastructure, learning facilities, and other areas. The transparent interaction with parents, alumni, students, teaching and non-teaching professors, enabled the committee to appraise the initiatives undertaken by the college at all levels. The peer team members not only visited all academic facilities, administrative and support services offered by the college but also visited the various internship institutions and community centres and interacted with the concerned authorities. The documentary evidence was cross-examined by them. Students displayed a cultural performance to showcase their talents.



On October 19, 2023, the peer team members held an exit meeting during which the report was handed over to the Principal. The entire procedure allowed the college to evaluate its institutional capabilities. RCoEd secured 'B+' grade with a CGPA score of 2.58 in the first cycle of academic evaluation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).

Diwali Celebration RCoEd (November 8, 2023)

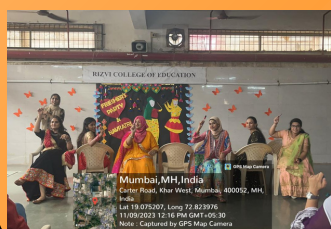
