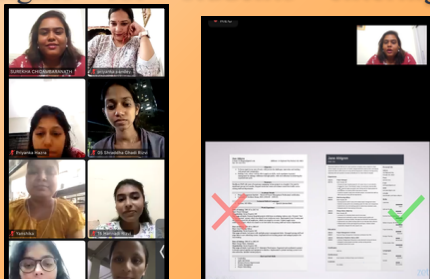

RCoEd (December 13, 2023)

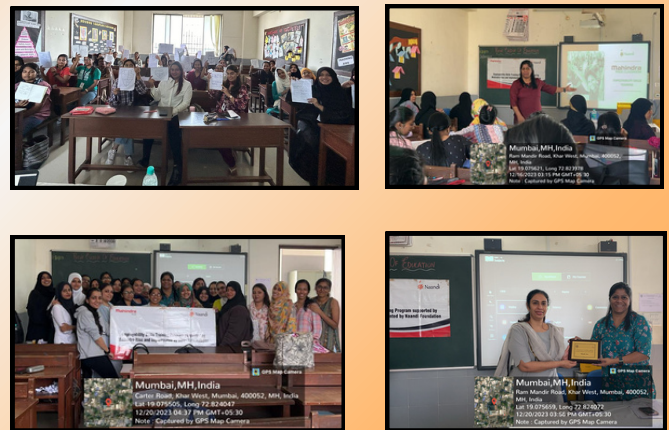

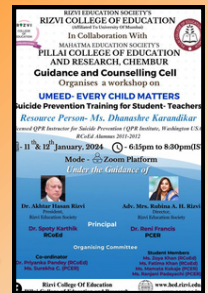
Picnic RCoEd (January 6, 2024)

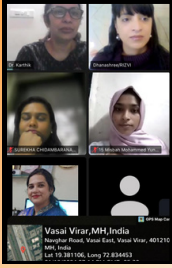
Umeed - "Every Child Matters" RCoEd (January 11 & 12, 2024)

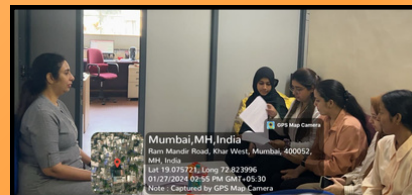
Beach Cleanup Drive RCoEd (January 20, 2024)
