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Teacher's Day Celebration RCoEd (September 5, 2022)

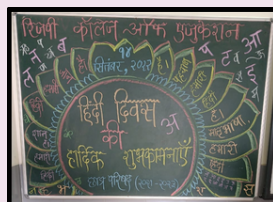

RCoEd (September 17, 2022)

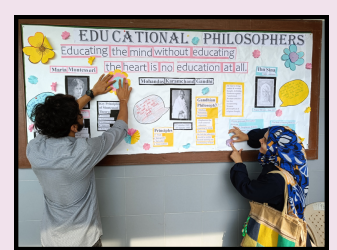

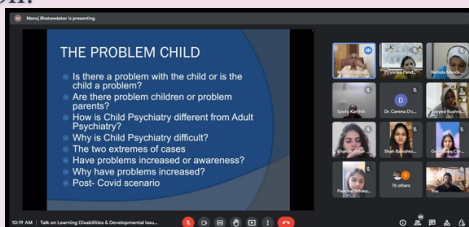
Employability Programme RCoEd (October 11, 2022)

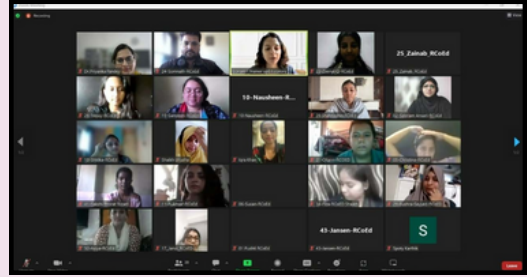
Learning Disability Awareness Month RCoEd (October 15, 2022)

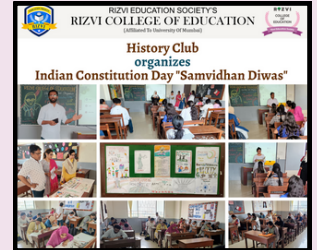


Samvidhan diwas
