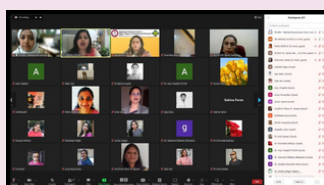
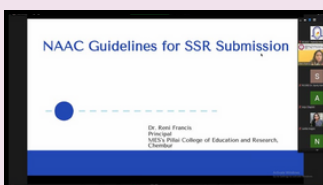
Eid Party RCoEd (April 26, 2023)
