in various yoga asanas and meditation practices. It exemplified the unity and harmony that yoga can foster, bringing educators and students together to promote holistic health and inner peace.

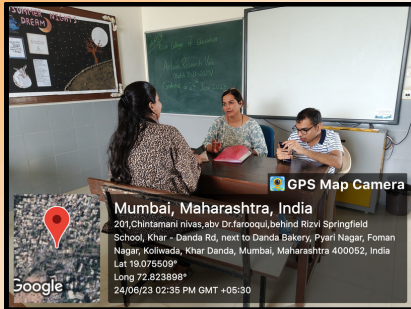
**Reunion- Alumni Association

### RCoEd (July 12 to July 14)

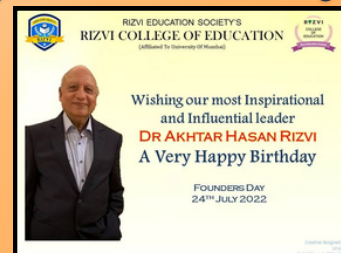
