1. Portfolio Development Session

The college Placement Cell organised a session on portfolio designing and development on December 17th, 2018 led by Mrs. Pooja Mishra. The session trained student taechers to frame appropriate Cover letter and develop an impactful CV along with E-Portfolio development.

2. Personal Grooming and Interview skills

How you appear at an interview can be crucial to your chances of success. A session was conducted by Mrs. Pooja Mishra & Mrs. Mrs. Spoty Karthik which explained the importance for all candidates to follow proper hygiene, grooming and dress code practices to create a positive impression on the interview during a job interview.

3. Mock interview and Classroom Situation Test

Different panels consisting of the teacher educators of the college were made and the mock interview of all the student teachers were conducted on 04th January, 2019. Students were asked questions on general knowledge, current affairs, educational reforms, content knowledge and its pedagogy. They were assessed on their communication skills, teacher personality appearance and conduct as well. There CVs and covering letters were also scrutinised and

suggestions given. After the mock interview they were given a Situation Test where classroom scenarios were provided and student teachers where asked how they would handle the situation.

4. Placement Drive

The placement drive for academic year 2018-19 was conducted from 10th-12th January, 2019. College invited several schools, colleges, and NGOs to participate in the drive.
