GUDI PADWA CELEBRATION -2023

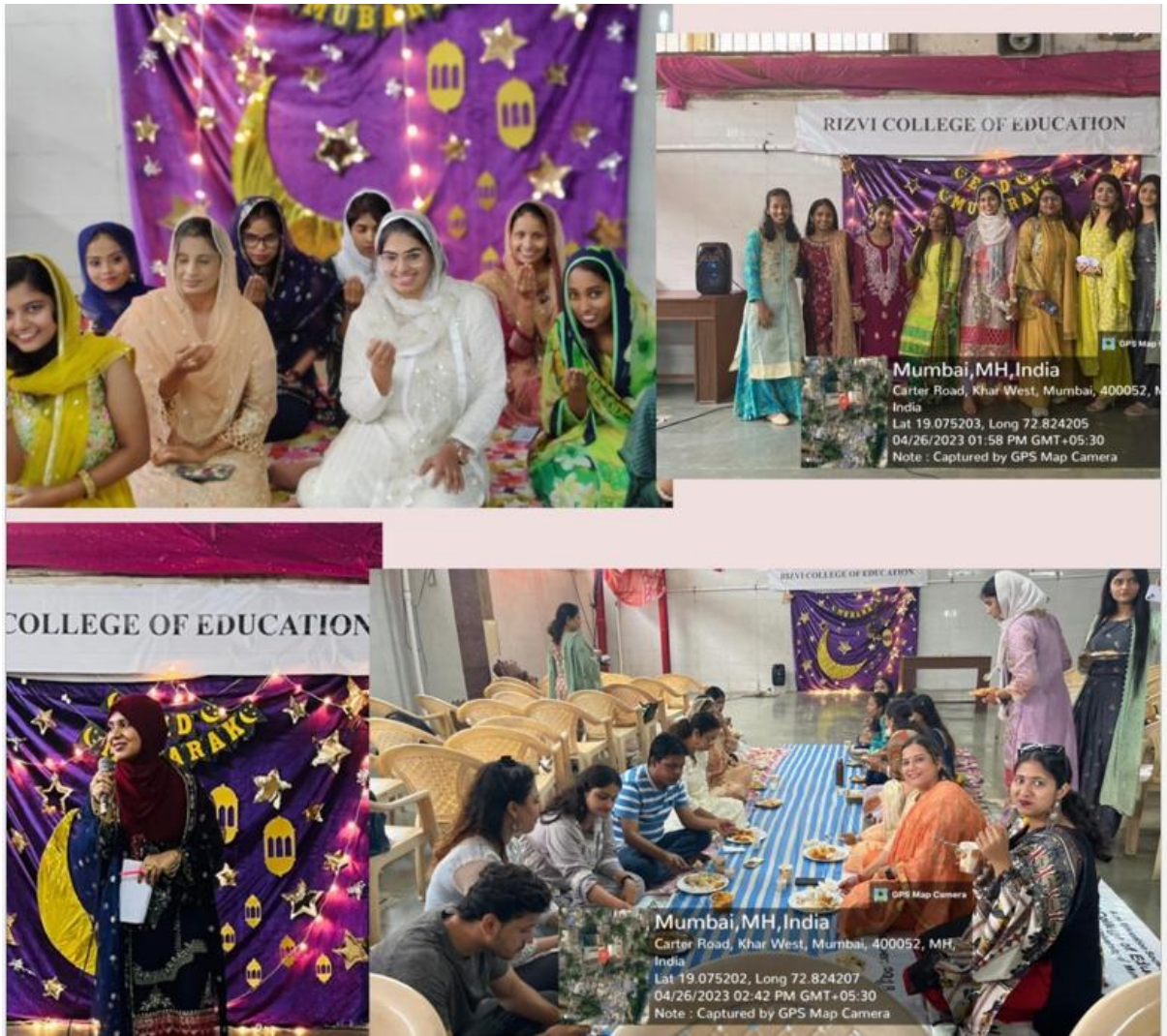

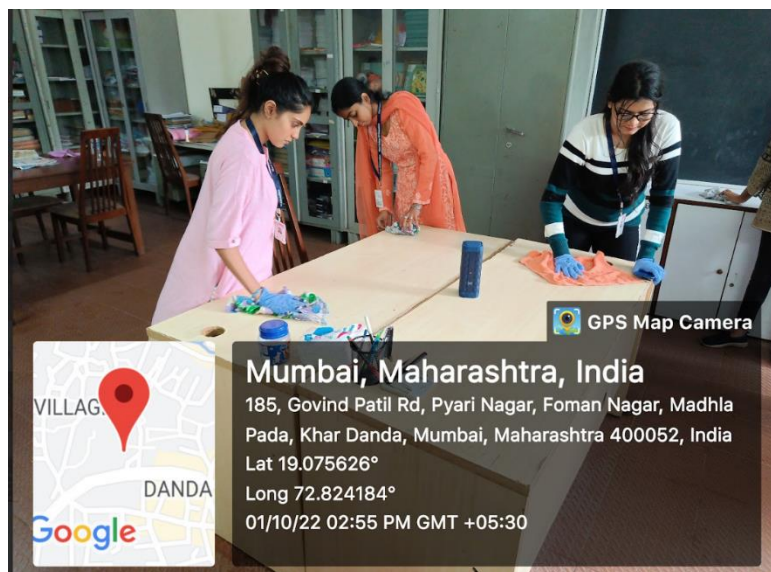

‘Shram Daan Event’-2022

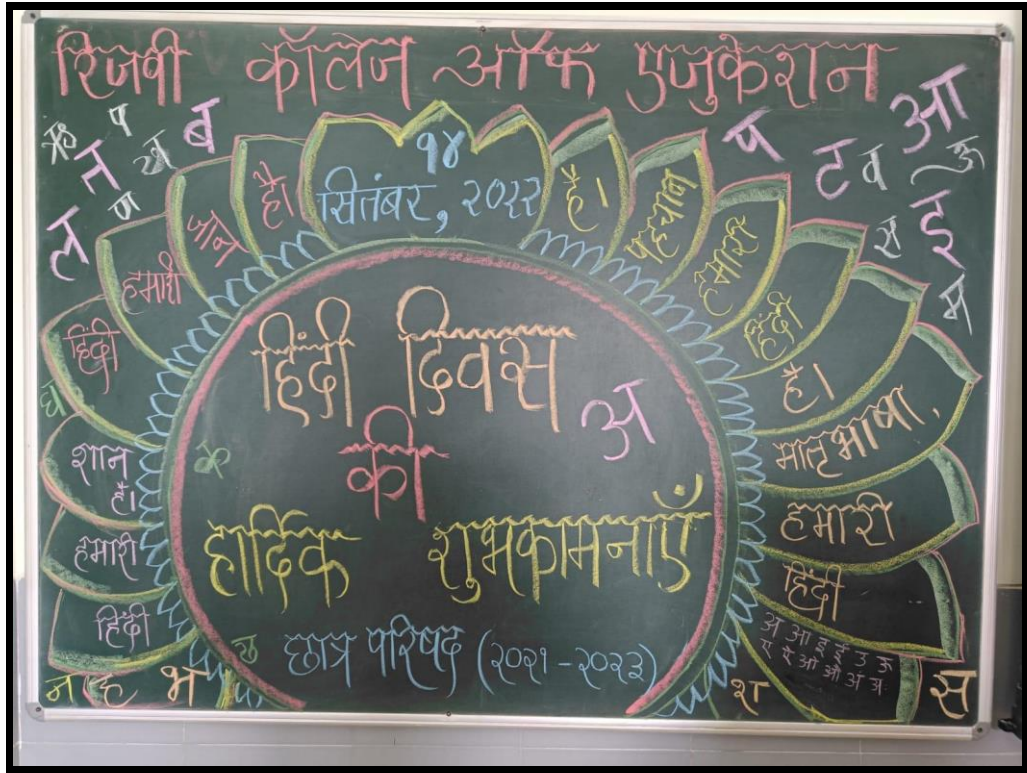

FOUNDERS DAY-2021

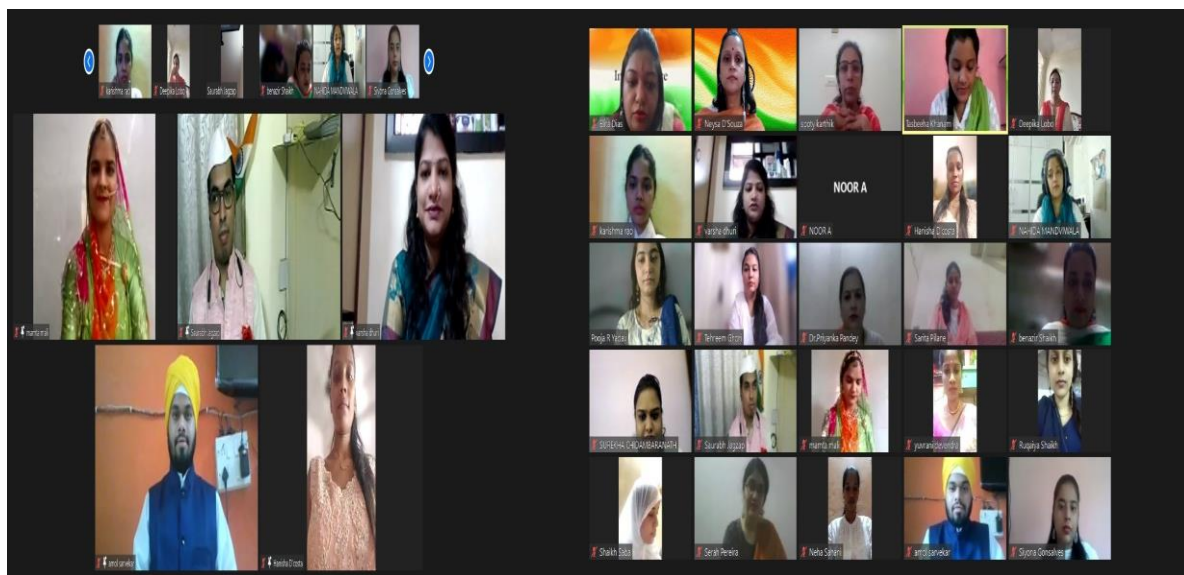

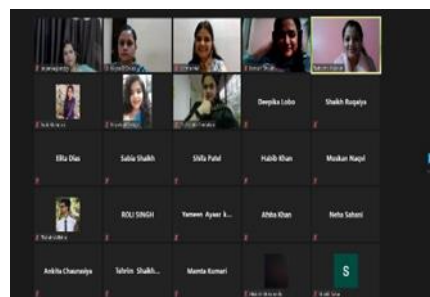
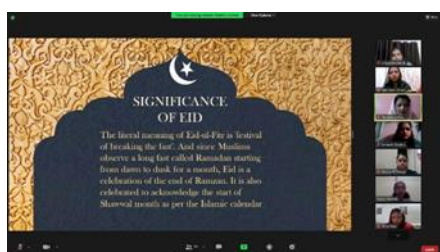


EID CELEBEATION-2021

An Eid Celebration was held in Rizvi College of Education on 17th May 2021, organised by the student council team for all the students on zoom.

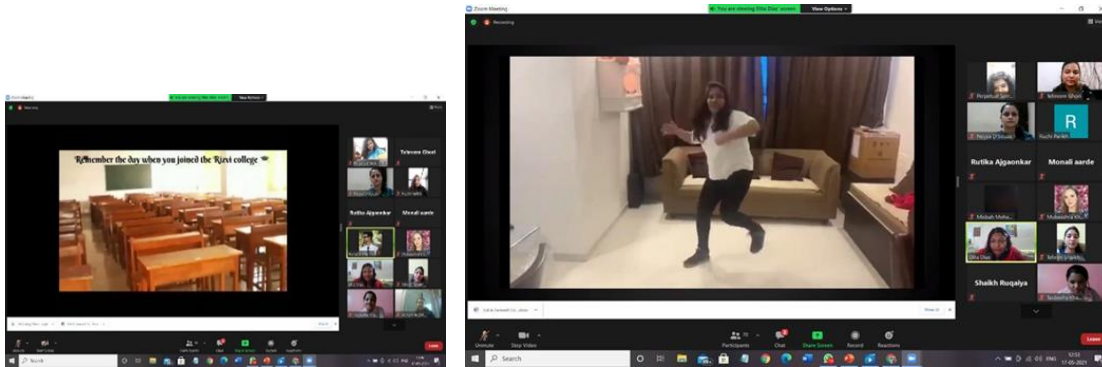
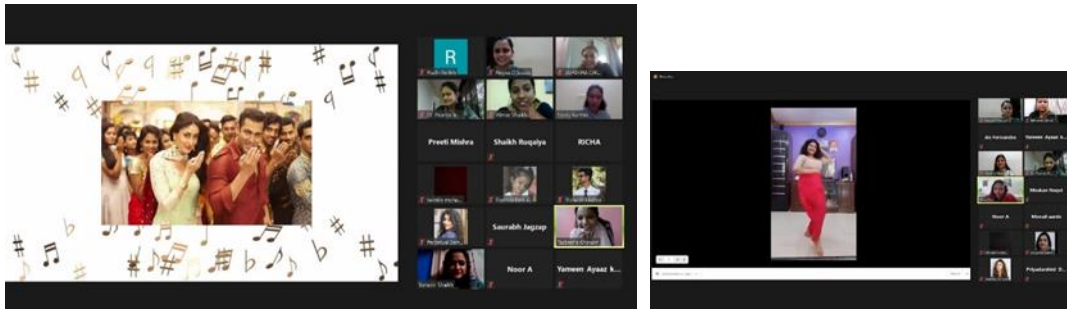
