To celebrate Gudi Padwa, the FY.B.Ed. students held a special assembly. Everyone was thrilled to see that, in addition to the Maharashtrian students,


students from other castes also participated enthusiastically in the assembly while donning sarees and the nath.

The assembly began with the college prayer, which was followed




by the Devi Geet. The FY students then delivered two speeches in Marathi. The students then invited the professors to participate in the puja.
