The students were welcomed to new Semester on 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2023. The Principal took a review of the Semester 2 exam and if they found any difficulties while writing the papers. The students appreciated the guidance periods that were allotted before the exam where they understood how to divide their time for each answer.

The students were welcomed to the new Semester by the newly appointed principal Dr. Spoty Karthik. The Principal appreciated the students for having written good assignments during the first semester. However she stressed that essay and class test have to be focused upon. Importance of attendance was clearly highlighted. The principal further gave a brief overview of the core courses and the project based course in Semester 2.



Later the core papers were introduced along with the respective teachers. The concerned faculty members introduced the core papers, its learning objectives and the way assessments will be carried out. Students were informed about the schedule for assignment submission, essay and class test dates, etc.

Third semester has a very heavy practicum of 11 weeks and theory course. It has 2 compulsory courses and one elective course. The Orientation commenced with the Principal welcoming the students to the new semester. The principal explained the importance of assignment submission and effective assignment presentation was explained, essay test and class test was stressed upon. The principal further introduced the papers and the faculty in-charge for each paper. The faculty for project based course was introduced and it was stressed that the Project Based Course in Semester 3 holds a lot of weightage and quality in internship is extremely important. Project based course was explained in depth. The various activities to be completed in Semester 3 internship was explained. It was highlighted that a part from regular lessons students have to deliver theme based and co-teaching lessons. The importance of reflective journaling was emphasized. The concerned faculty members gave a detailed orientation of the syllabus of the compulsory papers and its objectives and learning outcomes were explained. An orientation to Elective Course 2 was given in the respective groups.

#### **Semester IV**

Date - 17-02-2024

Time – 11 am

Venue – Room 502 – SY.B.Ed Class

After Semester 3 examinations the students resumed college from 17<sup>th</sup> February 2024. The students were welcomed to the Semester IV and an orientation of the same was conducted. The orientation was divided into 2 parts viz. theory and practicum. The Principal introduced the Semester 4 Theory and practicum. She layed utmost importance by stressing upon regularity and punctuality in college related activities. A detailed orientation of each paper was conducted by the concerned staff where course objectives, tentative dates of assignment submission, essay and class test dates were discussed.

The first orientation was held on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 conducted on practicum, as within a month majority schools would start with their final exams thus the students were given in depth orientation on the project-based course. The faculty in-charge Dr. Gyanprakash Arya and Dr. Priyanka explained the details of project-based course and a tentative schedule for the same was given. A detail orientation on Community work too was conducted.

CC5 – Contemporary India and Education by Dr. Gyanprakash Arya. A detailed orientation session of the paper was done, covering course objectives which include understanding diversity, inequalities, and constitutional values in Indian society, topics and tentative dates for assignment submissions, essay deadlines, and class test schedules.

IC4 – Creating an Inclusive School by Ms. Jyoti Bhatia, the students were given an overview about the learnings in the curriculum paper. They were informed that they would gain insights into the diverse abilities and characteristics of students, and study national and international frameworks related to disability and inclusion. Additionally, they would learn strategies to cultivate diversity-friendly environments in schools and classrooms. Students were also informed about topics and tentative dates for assignment submissions, essay deadlines, and class test schedules.

The second orientation was held on 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 conducted on Ability Course 2 – Reading and Reflecting on Texts by Mrs. Nahida Mandviwala, where the paper's aims and objectives were explained to the students for each unit, along with the corresponding activities to be completed. The session highlighted the significance of developing interpretation and reflective writing skills, as well as generating critical responses and maintaining reflective journals throughout the course. Additionally, the details concerning the assignment topic and submission requirements were discussed.

During the orientation session led by Dr. Priyanka Pandey, students were briefed on the curriculum of paper EC3 - Guidance and Counselling. They were informed about the objectives, which include grasping fundamental concepts, exploring strategies for guidance and counseling, understanding career guidance and job satisfaction, and developing skills to address adolescent psychological issues. The session provided a clear roadmap for their learning journey in the paper. Additionally, assignment topic, essay and class test schedules were discussed.

Apart from the above papers detailed orientation was conducted on learning resources and notice pertaining to the same were displayed on the college notice board.

A detailed orientation of Action Research was conducted in January 2024.
