### Activity Summary Report: Environmental Film Screening

On **5th December 2024**, the Environment Cell of Rizvi College of Education, in collaboration with the **All Living Things Environmental Film Festival (ALT EFF)**, organized an **Environmental Film Screening** exclusively for **FY B.Ed. (Batch 2024–2026)** students.

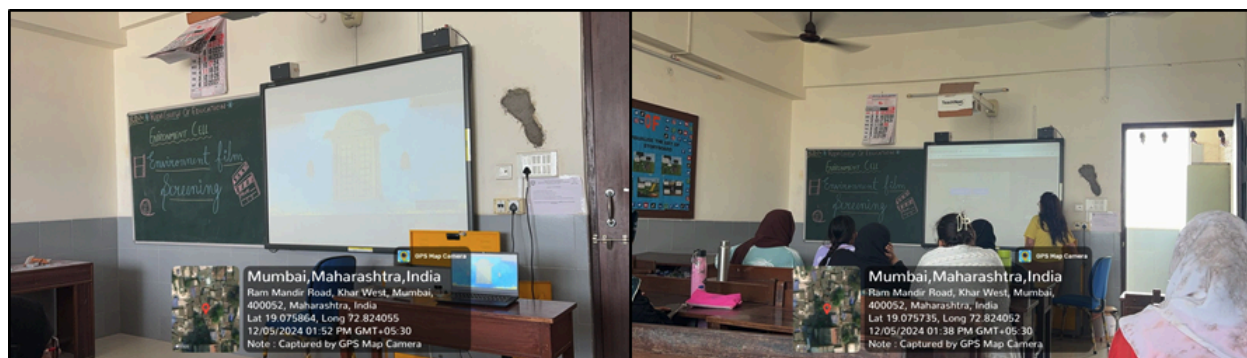
The session aimed to **raise awareness about critical environmental issues** through impactful visual storytelling and to inspire students to adopt sustainable practices in their daily lives. A total of **15 student teachers** participated in the screening.

The event featured **seven thought-provoking films** covering diverse environmental topics, including species conservation, deforestation, climate change, and community-driven ecological initiatives:

- *Phool Dei* – The impact of migration and ecological changes in Uttarakhand, India
- *The Forest of Honey Bees* – Importance of bees for ecosystems in France
- *Batsies* – Conservation of bat populations in Texas, USA
- *Mother of the Forest (Curupira)* – Amazon rainforest conservation, Brazil
- *Kenya's Desert Alert* – Deforestation and climate change impacts in Kenya
- *Saving the Bone Swallower* – Grassroots efforts to protect the endangered Greater Adjutant stork, India
- *Wild Hope: One Golden Chance* – Saving the Golden Lion Tamarin from extinction, Brazil

The screening was followed by **interactive reflections**, allowing students to discuss key environmental challenges and the role of humans in conservation. Participants gained valuable insights into global ecological issues, the importance of biodiversity, and practical ways to contribute to sustainability.

The session successfully **achieved its objectives**, fostering environmental consciousness and reinforcing the role of future educators in promoting ecological awareness. The films provided a powerful medium for connecting with nature, inspiring students to act as responsible environmental stewards.
