- Handwritten essays should be neatly scanned and submitted in PDF format, while typed essays should be submitted in PDF (.pdf) format.
- It is mandatory to upload a copy of the School Identity Card while filling the Google Form.
- All entries must be submitted through the Google Form link provided.
- Do not mention the name of student and /or school on the essay paper, All the information will be filled in Google Form only.
- The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
