- Participants may use original photographs, videos, voiceovers, animation, graphics, and free background music.
- The content must be original and should not infringe any copyright.
- AI-generated or plagiarized entries will be disqualified.
- The reel should clearly reflect the competition theme.
- Participants must upload the reel in MP4 format (Maximum 100 MB).
- Do not mention the name of student and /or college in the Reel, All the information will be filled in Google Form only.
- Upload valid college identity card on the google form.
- All entries will only be accepted through the Google Form link provided.
