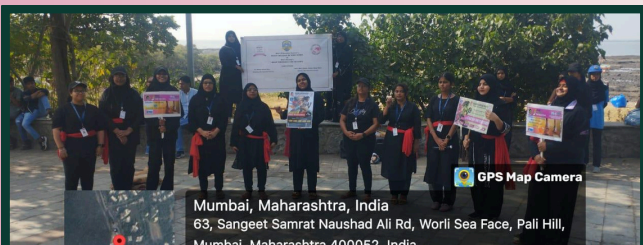
**Through the Reviewer's Lens: A session on R.K. Narayan's Literary Impact RCoEd (November 23, 2024)**
