Report on Action Research Viva Voce

Date: 21st June 2025

Venue: Room No. 503 and 504

Course: B.Ed. (Semester IV) – Action Research

The Action Research Viva Voce for the Fourth Semester B.Ed. students was conducted on Saturday, 21st June 2025, at Rizvi College of Education, as part of the internal and external assessment for the Action Research component. To facilitate a systematic and organized evaluation process, the students were divided into two groups based on their roll numbers:

Group 1: Roll Numbers 1 to 10

Group 2: Roll Numbers 11 to 19

Each group was assigned a separate venue:

Room 503 for Group 1

Room 504 for Group 2

All students were present for the viva and actively participated in the discussion. The viva was conducted in the presence of two external examiners, Ms. Bushra and Ms. Shabnam, who brought their expertise and academic experience to the assessment process. The external examiners thoroughly reviewed each student's action research project, posed relevant questions, and offered insightful suggestions for improvement. They were supported by two internal examiners, Dr. Shweta Srivastava and Ms. Nazia, who co-evaluated the students' performance and contributed to the critical appraisal of their work.

During the viva, each student was required to

- Present the research problem they had identified during their internship or classroom engagement.
- Explain the objectives of their research.
- Describe the intervention strategies implemented to address the problem.
- Share details of the data collection methods, analysis, and interpretation of results.
- Reflect on the impact of their intervention and the leanings from their action research experience.

The session allowed students to articulate their understanding of classroom-based research, promote reflective thinking, and demonstrate their growth as future educators capable of using research as a tool for problem-solving. The examiners appreciated the students' efforts in
